Anneliese Amber 5.8%

12oz. \$4.25

To Go: Growler Fill \$12.00

Named after Bret's second daughter, this Ale exhibits the finest citrus hop aroma, followed by sweet caramel balance. Malty caramel upfront, medium to low bitterness, nice hop flavor although it is not overbearing.



DRIPA 9.5%

10oz Tulip \$6.00

To Go: Growler Fill \$17.00

This gold colored West Coast style Double India Pale Ale has an intense hop nose, with aromas mainly of citrus. The high hop character dominates this IPA's flavor profile. Made with American long grain rice, it is quite difficult to make but the rice contributes to this beer's crisp aftertaste.



Imperial Crème Brule Java Stout 7%

10oz Tulip \$7.00

To Go: Growler Fill \$28.00

This black in color imperial stout's aroma is lead by coffee and dry roasty notes. Crème Brûlé coffee is brewed and added post-fermentation. This killer stout is highly sought after at every tasting we take it to.



Kuhnenn Fest 4.75%

12oz. \$4.25

To Go: Growler fill \$13.00

This is our version of Oktoberfest/Marzen bier. Made with Munich malt, this traditional red lager is smooth, malty, with a clean finish. Anyone looking for a "red beer" has found what they are looking for.



Export Stout 7.25%

12oz. \$4.25

To Go: Growler Fill \$12.00

This is a roasty, malty, chocolaty, easy drinking Export Stout. Rich in flavor with a clean finish.



Hefeweizen 5%

12oz. \$4.25

To Go: Growler fill \$13.00

Don't ask for a lemon my friend, this wheat beer stands on it's own. This traditional German wheat beer is a summer favorite. Flavors of banana and clove are present in this unfiltered beer, made with German malted wheat.



Metry's Winter Lager 7%

12oz. \$5.25

To Go: Growler Fill \$14.00

The return of the Metry's, it is a very light lager in color. It has a light, sweet grainy aroma with Noble hops present. This beer is well balanced and finishes clean. A light beer with a lot of alcohol, so be careful!!



Loonie Kuhnle Pale Ale 5.8%

12oz. \$ 4.25

To Go: Growler fill \$12.00

Gold in color, this ale has a light caramel malt flavor and a strong citrus hop aroma. This batch was dry hopped with over a pound per barrel of Cascade hops, making it refreshing and satisfying.



Simcoe Silly 9%

10oz. Tulip \$5.50

To Go: Growler Fill \$15.00

This Pale American Belgo style beer was 2010 GABF's silver medal winner. It has notes of spicy pineapple, mango bubblegum aromas which comes from the unique marriage of a special Belgian yeast and an American Simcoe hop. This beer has an initial soft malt sweetness with orange fruitiness and finishes with a hoppy dryness.



Bourbon Barrel 4th Dementia 13.5%

10oz. \$7.00

This is our 4th Dementia Olde Ale that has been bourbon barrel aged. This ale has an intense sweet caramel malt flavor and aroma that develops into a toffee/toasted marsh mellow like character.



American IPA 6.5%

12oz \$5.00

To Go: Growler fill \$14.00

Amber in color; unfiltered, so it is not crystal clear. Quite bitter with a balance of malty caramel-like sweetness. Aroma is of intense dry hopping; meaningful lots of hops were added late in the beer making process, post boiling.

This black in color porter has a roasty, caramel, low hop aroma. It has a lightly burnt malty taste with a medium dry finish. A clean refreshing porter.



Kolsch 4.1%

12 oz. \$4.25

To Go: Growler Fill \$12.00

This Light Hybrid Ale was made by Phil Sullivan, Midwest Home Brewer of the year. It is very pale gold in color with brilliant clarity. Exhibiting very low hop aroma, this crisp beer has a delicate balance of soft malt and gentle dryness. We are extremely honored to serve this beer and very proud of Phil's notable accomplishment.



Timmy T's 4.5%

12oz. \$4.25

To Go: Growler fill \$12.00

This English-style Pale Ale was made with a special English yeast strain and spicy European hops. It is light in color, sweet upfront with a dry finish. Letting this beer warm up will brighten it and make the flavors more apparent.



Prometheus 11%

10oz. \$7.00

This Belgian style Quadrupel was inspired by the Trappist brewers of Belgium. It is deep red in color and moderately sweet, bread like, and malty on the nose. Full bodied, this complex beer is slightly sweet with a rich malty balance.



Nine 10%

This beer is a Belgian Dark Strong, black in color, it has aromas of rich dry malt and a slight caramel sweetness. Rich and smooth there is not any bitterness to this full bodied beer. The high alcohol level in this beer provides some balance of it's malty palate.
